Election Re-Count Results of the Sudbury Métis Council

On December 6, 2010 there was an official request to the Chief Electoral Officer to have a re-count of ballots for the position of President for the Sudbury Métis Council. As per Article B34.1 of the Sudbury Métis Council's Community Electoral Code a Re-count date was set for December 18, 2010 and both candidates sent a representative to witness the count.

There were a total of 245 ballots cast between the Advance Poll on December 1, 2010 and the Election on December 5, 2010 with 2 spoiled ballots and 1 objection to the eligibility of an elector for a total of 248 ballots issued.

After the re-count on December 18, 2010 there were a total of 242 ballots cast for the position of President. Two of the spoiled ballots were ruled to be valid and the contested ballot was not allowed in the final count as the elector failed to produce photo identification when presenting himself to the polling clerk.

The final count for the position of President is as follows:

Richard Sarrazin – 119 Votes
Roger Giroux – 123 Votes

Therefore the election results stand for the position of President and the following candidates have been elected to a three year mandate;
