MNO-Timmins Métis Council Official Election Results

June 7, 2015

The MNO Timmins Métis Council through council resolution appointed me as their electoral officer to supervise council's June 6, 2015 election to ensure a fair election consistent with the *MNO Timmins Métis Council Community Electoral Code*. I was responsible to conduct, oversee and be responsible for all matters concerning the election of the community council, to ensure a fair and impartial election process and take any steps necessary to ensure the effective implementation of the *MNO Timmins Métis Council Community Electoral Code*.

As per Article B33.1 of the *MNO Timmins Métis Council Community Electoral Code* it is my duty to officially announce the results of the MNO Timmins Métis Council elections and declare elected those candidates who received the largest number of votes.

After the Close of Nominations on May 25, 2015 there were a total of 11 nominees for the 12 positions available on the MNO Timmins Métis Council, 11 nominees were verified with 8 positions being acclaimed, two positions remaining vacant, one candidate was eliminated based on his residency being outside the council boundary and the Chair position having two candidates resulting in ballot box elections to decide the successful candidate.
