As per Article B33.1 of the *Temiskaming Métis Council Community Electoral Code* it is my duty to officially announce the results of the Temiskaming Métis Council elections and declare elected those candidates who received the largest number of votes.

After the Close of Nominations on January 6, 2017 there were a total of 7 nominees for the 9 positions available on the Temiskaming Métis Council, 6 nominees were verified and all 6 positions have been acclaimed resulting in no ballot box elections and 3 positions on council remaining vacant.
