# DECLARATION OF RELATIONSHIP

To apply for citizenship with the Métis Nation of Ontario (MNO), an individual is required to provide authorized government photo identification verifying they are who they say they are and that they do reside in the province of Ontario. Individuals who do not possess this type of identification can still apply providing they can obtain a declaration from either someone related to them by blood or marriage or by a person who has known them for a minimum of five years.

**By completing and signing this form you are declaring that the MNO citizenship applicant is who he/she says he/she is and that they reside in the province of Ontario.**
