

Call for Advisory Committee Members (volunteers)

Northern Housing Rights: Promoting Housing Rights among Métis, First Nation, and Inuit Communities in Northwestern Ontario

The Centre for Equality Rights in Accommodation (CERA) in partnership with the Métis Nation of Ontario (MNO) has secured funding through the Law Foundation of Ontario to undertake human rights and rental housing education, research and capacity building in Northwestern Ontario. This project is targeted to Métis, First Nation and Inuit people and the agencies that provide them with housing and related services.

Projects activities include:

- Education and community outreach sessions
- Education sessions for social housing providers
- Informative resource material, video, and education Campaign
- Public report of findings

MNO and CERA are seeking 5 -7 Northwestern Ontario representatives from the Métis, First Nation and Inuit communities/councils, along with housing and human rights experts. The Advisory Committee will guide the content of the materials produced and session outlines to ensure cultural and community inclusiveness and relevance.

Committee members will be consulted by way of email or telephone with no need to travel. The project length is 11 months with approximately 3-4 Advisory Committee meetings required.

Deadline for submissions is March 14, 2014.
