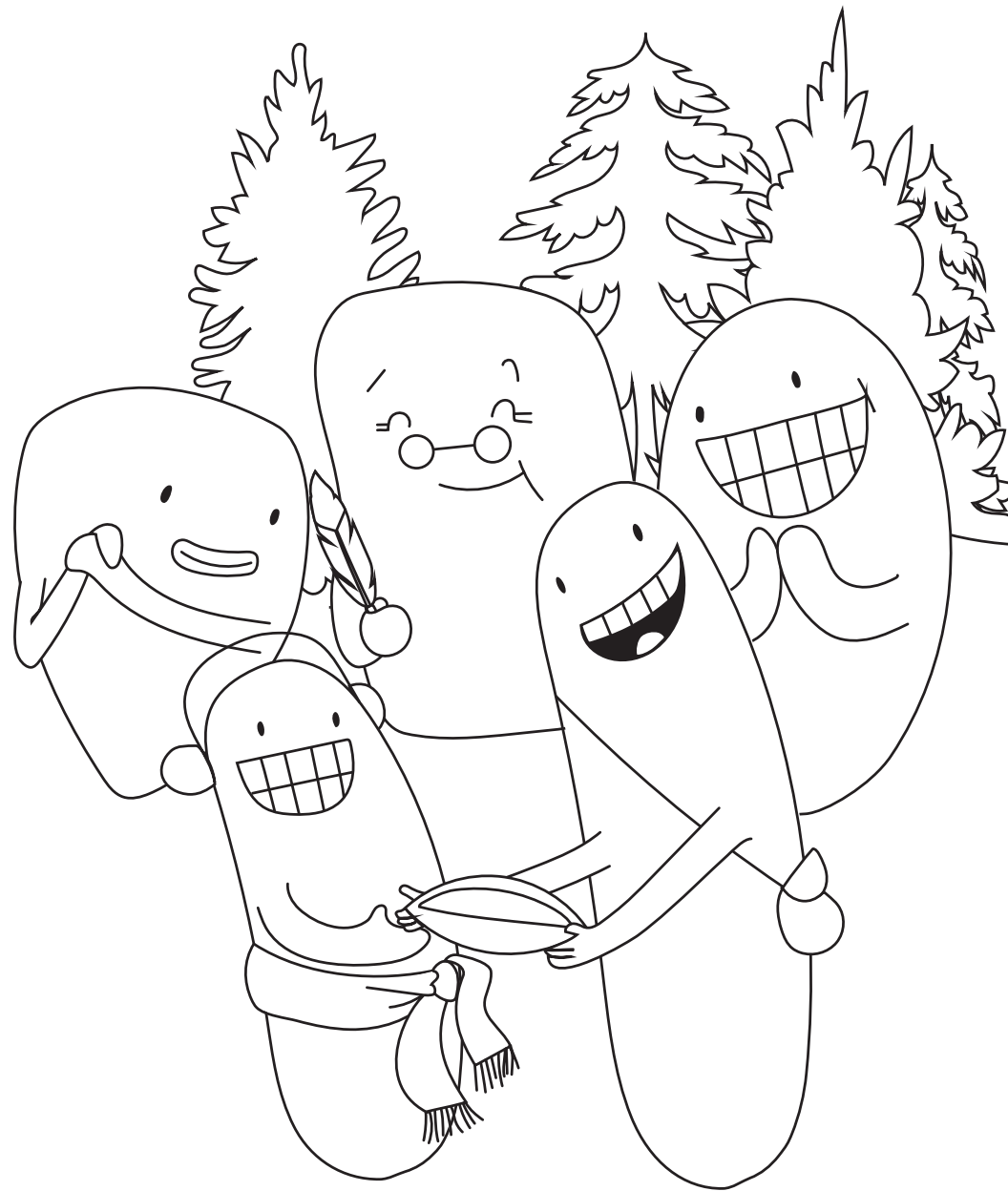


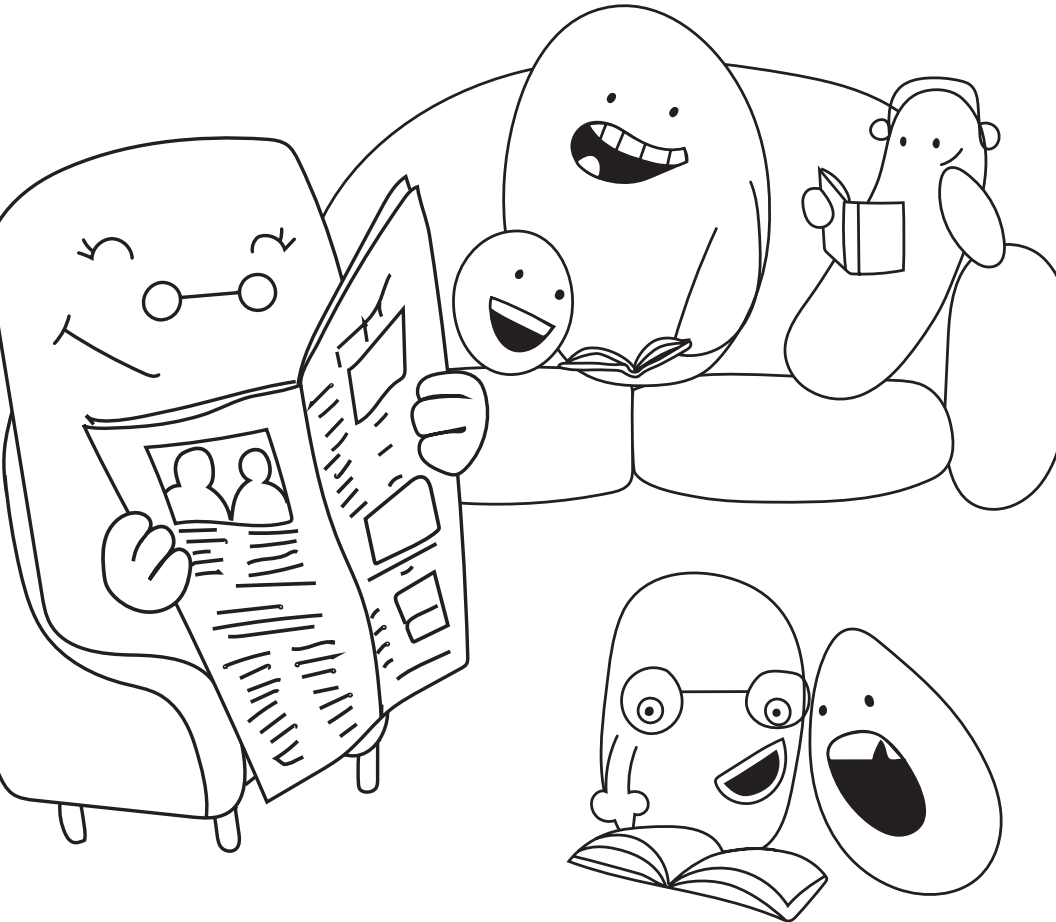
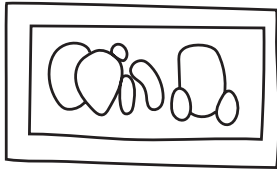
















A CIRCLE OF CARING
