As per the nomination requirements from Article 6 of the MNO Electoral Code: Part A, I declare that:

- I am an MNO Women's citizen (note that the Métis Nation of Ontario Women's Council has an inclusive understanding of womanhood including Transgender women and Inter-Sex women)
- I am sixteen (16) years of age or older;
- I am Ordinarily Resident in Ontario;
- If seeking the position of President, I will be Ordinarily Resident in Ontario for the term of office (which is four years);
- If seeking the position of Regional Representative, I am Ordinarily Resident in the Region in which I am seeking to be elected;
- I have no Outstanding Obligations to MNO;
- I am Verified according to the process set out by the MNO Registrar as amended from time to time;
- I have not been convicted within the past five years of an indictable offence;
- I have not been convicted, within the past five years, in connection with an Election, of corrupt practice, accepting a bribe, dishonesty or malfeasance; and
- I have not had my rights or privileges as an MNO citizen suspended by the PCMNO pursuant to the MNO Electoral Code: Part A, the MNO Policy – Conditions or Limitations that May Apply to MNO Citizenship, or the MNO Bylaws.

Further, as per Article 6.4 of the MNO Electoral Code: Part A, I solemnly affirm that:

My name is _____. I am Métis and I am a descendant of the historic Métis Nation. I affirm that I do not identify as Indian or as Inuit and I am not registered as an Indian under either the Indian Act or any band membership code or as an Inuk under an Inuit Registry. I am and for the duration of my term of office shall remain Ordinarily Resident in the province of Ontario. If elected for a regional office shall remain resident in that region for the duration of my term of office. I pledge my allegiance to the MNO as the only representative political body for the Métis in Ontario. I agree with the aims and objectives of the MNO as stated in the Statement of Prime Purpose.
