PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR MNO VETERAN MEMBERSHIP

Citizenship:

- To apply for Métis Veteran's Council membership, one must be a citizen of the Métis Nation of Ontario. This is substantiated by being in possession of a Métis Nation of Ontario citizenship card with a valid MNO registration number. This number is required to be inserted on the MNOVC Application form. In addition, please provide copy of your MNO card.
- 2. For information regarding application for MNO Citizenship, refer to MNO Registration procedure available at: **metisnation.org/registry** or contact the Métis Nation Ontario Registrar toll free: **1-855-798-1006**.

Definition of veteran:

Any former member of the Canadian Armed forces who underwent basic training and was honourably discharged. This includes anyone who was a member of regular or reserve forces, and anyone who served in the Merchant Marines (Merchant Navy) during war time.

Veteran Membership:

- 1. To apply for Métis veteran's council membership MNO citizens can complete and sign the MNOVC application form and forward it, along with a copy of the applicant's MNO citizenship card and substantiating documents verifying military service. Examples of these documents include: Military Release Certificate, or NDI75 card (both sides), or CF 75, or CF 54, or any other documents that indicate honourable release from the Canadian Armed Forces or currently serving status. Please also include a copy of your citizenship card. Please note that these documents MUST accompany the MNOVC application form when the firm is submitted.
- 2. All military documentation received will be reviewed by the Veterans' Council.
- 3. Upon completion of document review, and confirmation of MNO citizenship with MNO Registry, the MNOVC shall advise the incumbent as to the status of their application.
- 4. Applications which are received by the MNOVC which are not properly completed or missing required documentation cannot be processed. To minimize delays of your application, ensure that the application form is completed and that all pertinent documentation is attached.
- 5. Once approved, the MNO Registrar will be informed and the applicant's MNO citizenship record will be updated reflect MNO veteran status.
