Moon River Métis Council Official Election Results

February 9, 2023

Through a council resolution, I was appointed as the Electoral Officer to supervise the Moon River Métis Council's election to ensure a fair election consistent with the MNO Community Council Electoral Code. I was responsible for conducting, overseeing, and ensuring an impartial election process, and taking any steps necessary to ensure the effective implementation of the Moon River Métis Council's Electoral Code. The election was hosted online with OneFeather from February 6, 2023 to February 9, 2023, with online voting open throughout all hours of the election. Telephone voting was also available on the first and last day of the election between 4-8 PM Eastern Time.

After the Close of Nominations on January 20, 2023, there were eighteen (18) nominees for the ten (10) positions on the Moon River Métis Council. The MNO Registry verified the eighteen (18) nominees. Two (2) positions were acclaimed, leaving sixteen (16) candidates running for the following positions: one (1) President, one (1) Chair, one (1) Treasurer, one (1) Senator, one (1) Women's Representative, and three (3) Councilors-at-Large.

As per Article B33.1 of the Moon River Métis Council's Community Electoral Code, it is my duty to announce the results of the elections and declare elected those candidates who received the largest number of votes. The following candidates have been elected to a four (4) year term.
