As per the nomination requirements in Article 6 of MNO Electoral Code Part A, I accept this nomination and declare that:

- I am a Verified MNO citizen;
- I am a Veteran (defined as such by the MNOVC in its MNO Charter Agreement);
- I am ordinarily resident in Ontario;
- I have no outstanding obligations to MNO;
- I have not been convicted within the past five years of an indictable offence;
- I have not been convicted, within the past five years, in connection with an Election, of corrupt practice, accepting a bribe, dishonesty or malfeasance;
- I have not had my rights or privileges as an MNO citizen suspended;
- I am not currently nor was I in the one year prior to the date of the Election (May 6, 2024) a director or officer of another Aboriginal body where by being a director or officer, I would be placed in a conflict of interest situation;
- I have read the Métis Nation of Ontario Electoral Code: Part A, the MNO Bylaws, and the MNOVC Community Code and am eligible to be nominated as a Candidate in the MNO Election; and

I solemnly affirm that my name is _____. I am Métis and I am a descendant of the historic Métis Nation. I affirm that I do not identify as Indian or as Inuit and I am not registered as an Indian under either the Indian Act or any band membership code or as an Inuk under an Inuit Registry. I am and for the duration of my term of office shall remain Ordinarily Resident in the province of Ontario. If elected for a regional office shall remain resident in that region for the duration of my term of office. I pledge my allegiance to the MNO as the only representative political body for the Métis in Ontario. I agree with the aims and objectives of the MNO as stated in the Statement of Prime Purpose, and
