Complete forms must arrive in the office of the Electoral Officer before the close of the nomination deadline on July 15, 2024, at 4 PM (EST). Late submissions cannot be accepted.

Proof of Residence is required. *Electoral Code Part A 5.1 requires the following: Any Registered Citizen of the MNO who is Ordinarily Resident in Ontario is eligible to be an Elector must have been living in the geographic area at least one (1) month before the election announcement.*

For nominees to be able to run for an elected council position, the MNO Registry must also verify proof of residence (i.e. a valid driver's licence). You can submit this with your nomination form. For inquiries on other acceptable residence documents, please contact the MNO Registry at 1-855-798-1006 (Toll-Free).

The nomination form pages can be scanned, photographed, emailed, or printed and mailed. They must arrive at the office of the Electoral Officer by the nomination deadline date and time. If there are any concerns about possible mailing delays, please submit by email. Late arrivals will not be accepted.

The Electoral Officer will advise the nominees that have been verified by the MNO Registry (providing confirmation that rights and privileges as an MNO citizen have not been suspended).

Efforts will be made to have the official candidates list and acclamations publicized on the MNO's website three (3) days after the close of nominations. There may be slight delays due to the verification process. Official candidates must submit a written/email request to the Chief Electoral Officer for the voter list that will be available three (3) days after the official candidate announcement has been posted.

An elector or candidate may bring issues or concerns relating to the operation of the election to the Chief Electoral Officer, who may make a final and binding decision or determination on the issue or concern. Support with voting should also be directed to the Chief Electoral Officer.

- I have not been convicted of an indictable offence within the past five (5) years prior to the election date; and
- I have not been convicted of corrupt practice, accepting a bribe, dishonesty or malfeasance in relation to an election within the last five (5) years prior to the election date.
