



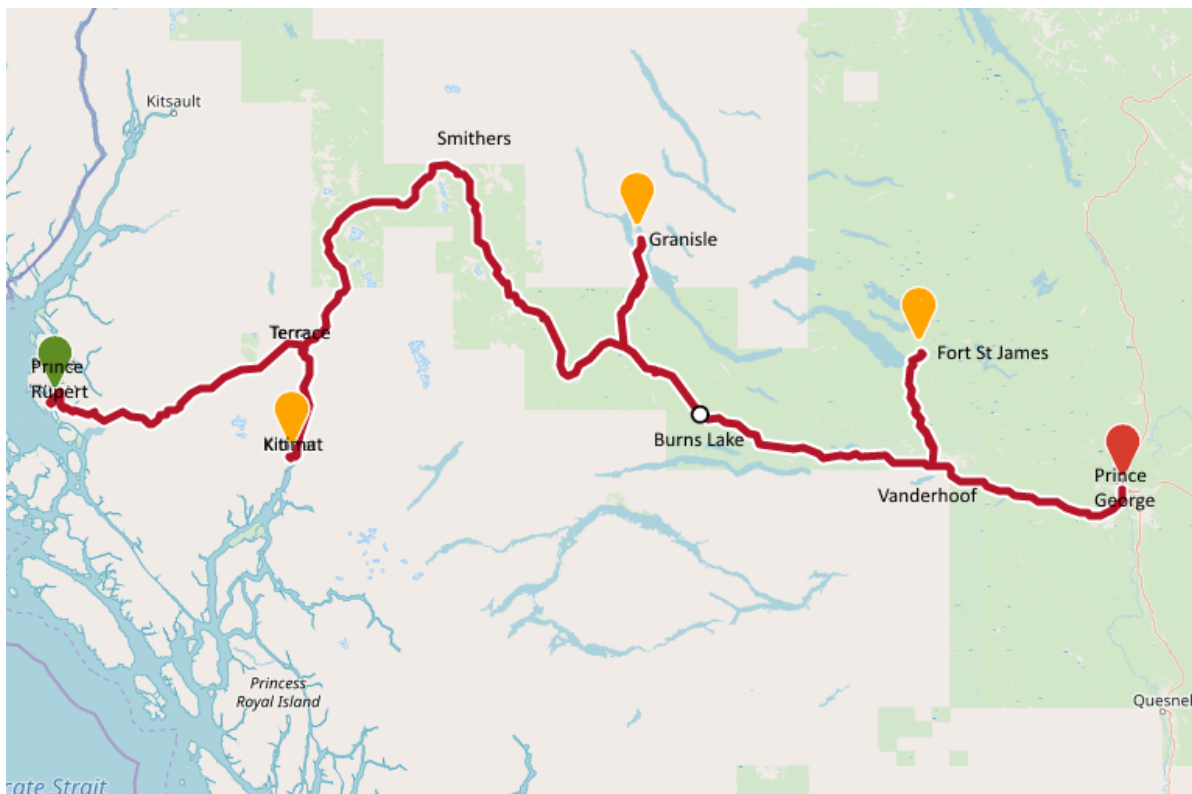
Highway of Tears

Introduction - A 750 km stretch of Highway 16 from Prince George to Prince Rupert, BC, has become known as the Highway of Tears. Between 1970 and 2020, it has been the site of many disappearances and murders of mostly young women and mostly Indigenous women. Official police records state 18 women have been reported missing along this stretch of road but locals put that number as much higher at over 80.
