After the close of this vacancy notice, all applicants will be verified as per **MNO Policy #2018-001**. Only those who meet the verification requirements will be considered.

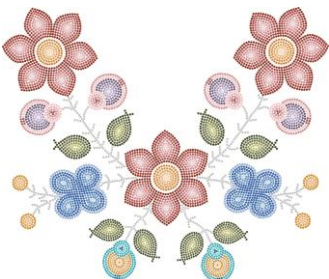
