## CHARTERED COMMUNITY COUNCIL OFFICIAL ELECTION RESULTS

### Métis Nation of Ontario Timmins

November 4, 2024

Through a council motion, I was appointed as the Electoral Officer to supervise the Métis of Ontario (MNO) - Timmins community council's election scheduled for November 21 - 25, 2024. I was responsible for conducting, overseeing, and being accountable for all matters concerning the community council's election, ensuring an impartial election process, and taking any steps necessary to provide a fair election consistent with implementing the MNO - Timmins Community Electoral Code.

There are twelve (12) positions on this council. Following the close of nominations on October 29, 2024, twelve (12) nominations were submitted, and all were verified as candidates. One (1) candidate withdrew. One (1) position is left vacant. As there are no contested positions, there will be **no ballot election**.

As per Article B33.1 of the MNO Timmins Council Community Electoral Code, it is my duty to announce the election results and declare the following candidates have been elected by acclamation to a four (4) year term.
