Temiskaming Métis Community Council

March 6, 2025

Through a council motion, I was appointed Electoral Officer to supervise the Temiskaming Métis Community Council's election scheduled for March 24-27, 2025. I was responsible for conducting, overseeing, and being accountable for all matters concerning the community council's election, ensuring an impartial election process, and taking any steps necessary to provide a fair election consistent with implementing the Temiskaming Métis Community Council Electoral Code.

There are ten (10) positions on the council. Following the close of nominations on March 5, 2025, six (6) nominations were submitted, and all were verified as candidates. Four (4) positions did not have nominations and remain vacant. As there were no contested positions and the council has met quorum, there will be **no election voting**.

As per Article B33.1 of the Temiskaming Métis Community Council Electoral Code, it is my duty to announce the election results and declare the following candidates have been elected by acclamation to a four (4) year term.
