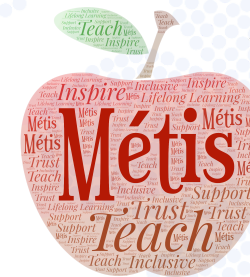


# Treaty Week - 1st week of November
