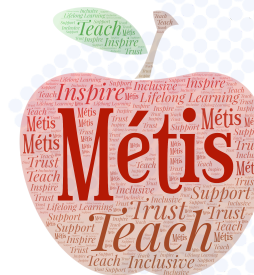


World Water Day - March 22
