## OFFICIAL ELECTION RESULTS

### Sudbury Métis Council

*June 18, 2025*

Through a council motion, I was appointed as the Electoral Officer to supervise the Sudbury Métis Council's election, ensuring a fair process in accordance with the MNO's Community Council Electoral Code. I was responsible for conducting, overseeing, and ensuring an impartial election process, taking all necessary steps to effectively implement the Sudbury Métis Council election. The election was hosted online with OneFeather from June 16 to June 18, 2025, with online voting available throughout its entire duration. Telephone voting was also offered on the first and last days of the election between 4 and 8 PM Eastern Time.

After the close of nominations on May 21, 2025, there were fourteen (14) nominees for the ten (10) positions on the Sudbury Métis Council. The MNO Registry verified thirteen (13) of those nominees. One (1) position had no candidate and remains vacant, seven (7) positions were acclaimed, leaving five (5) candidates running for the following positions: one (1) Senator and one (1) Women's Representative.

As per Article B33.1 of the Sudbury Métis Council's Community Electoral Code, it is my duty to announce the election results and declare those candidates who were acclaimed and those who received the highest number of votes as elected. The following candidates have been elected to a four (4) year term.

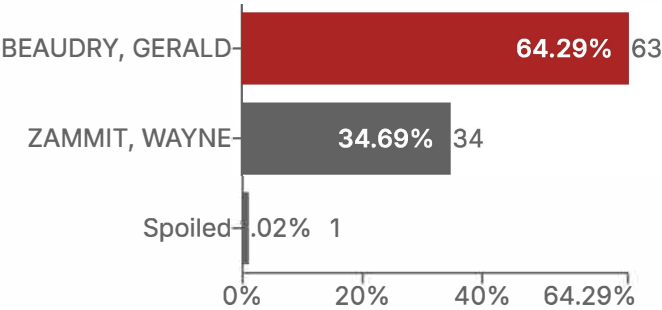

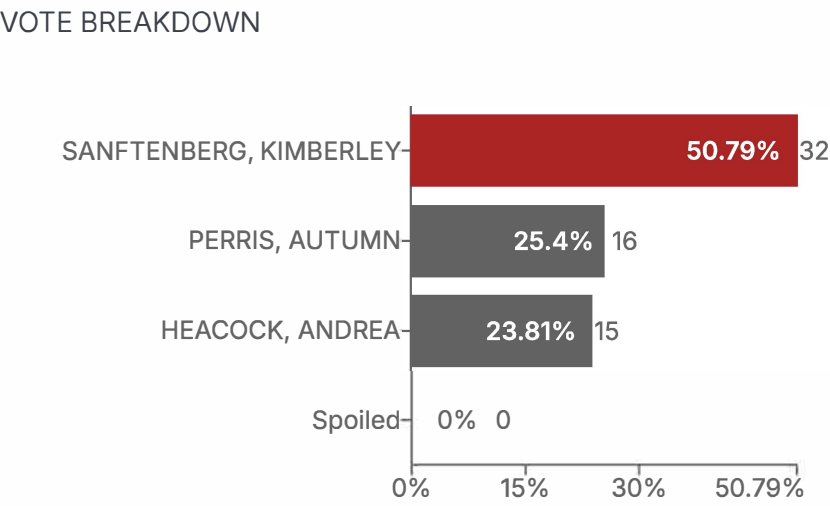
