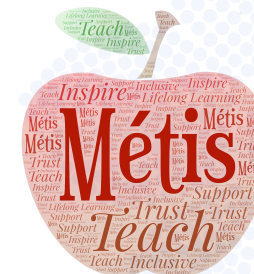


Louis Riel Day - November 16



Métis Significance

Louis Riel was a Canadian politician. He was also a founder of the province of Manitoba and a political leader of the Métis people in Canada. Louis Riel Day is observed on November 16. This day is the anniversary of Louis Riel's execution in 1885. MNO citizens, MNO Chartered Community Councils and communities hold events across the province to celebrate Métis culture, recognize the many contributions of the Métis to Canada, and highlight the struggles that Métis continue to face. On this day, a special ceremony is held at the Provincial Legislature at Queen's Park in Toronto.

Observed annually on November 16, Louis Riel Day solemnly marks the anniversary of Louis Riel's execution in 1885. This day is of profound historical importance, symbolizing Riel's pivotal leadership during the Northwest Resistance—a bold and courageous stance taken by the Métis community to resist the encroachment of the Canadian government upon their rights and way of life. Beyond the injustice of his execution, it is crucial to recognize Riel's remarkable political achievements and the substantial sacrifices he endured for the Métis people.
