October 16, 2025

Through a council motion, I was appointed Electoral Officer to supervise the Superior North Shore Métis Council's election scheduled for November 3-5, 2025. I was responsible for conducting, overseeing, and being accountable for all matters concerning the community council's election, ensuring an impartial election process, and taking any steps necessary to provide a fair election consistent with implementing the Superior North Shore Métis Council Electoral Code.

There are nine (9) positions on the council. Following the close of nominations on October 14, 2025, eight (8) nominations were submitted to fill eight (8) positions, and all were verified as candidates. One (1) position did not have nominations and remains vacant. As there were no contested positions and the council has met quorum, **there will be no election voting.**

As per Article B33.1 of the Superior North Shore Métis Council Electoral Code, it is my duty to announce the election results and declare the following candidates have been elected by acclamation to a three (3) year term:
