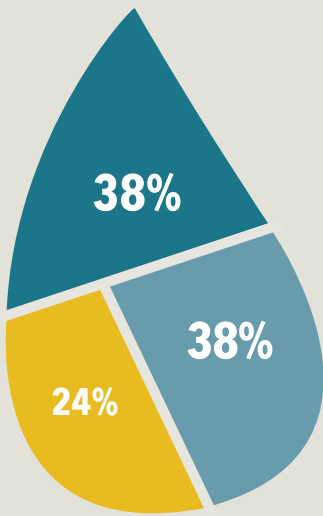

# 2025 FISH MONITORING SURVEY RESULTS

In early 2025, the MNO Environment and Climate Change team conducted a survey for MNO citizens who fish. See the key findings below:

## CITIZENS FISHED WITHIN MNO TRADITIONAL TERRITORIES



# 73%

**38%** of citizens fished recreational

**24%** fished for food

**38%** fished for both purposes

## MOST FISHING TRIPS DID NOT ENCOUNTER INVASIVE SPECIES

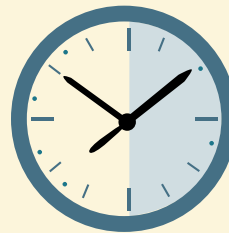


# 92%

*General health of fish was reported as good or excellent, none were reported as poor.*

## AVERAGE TIME SPENT FISHING



# 5 hours

Time spent fishing was fairly evenly split between morning, afternoon and evening.
