ABOUT THE MNO EDUCATION HUB

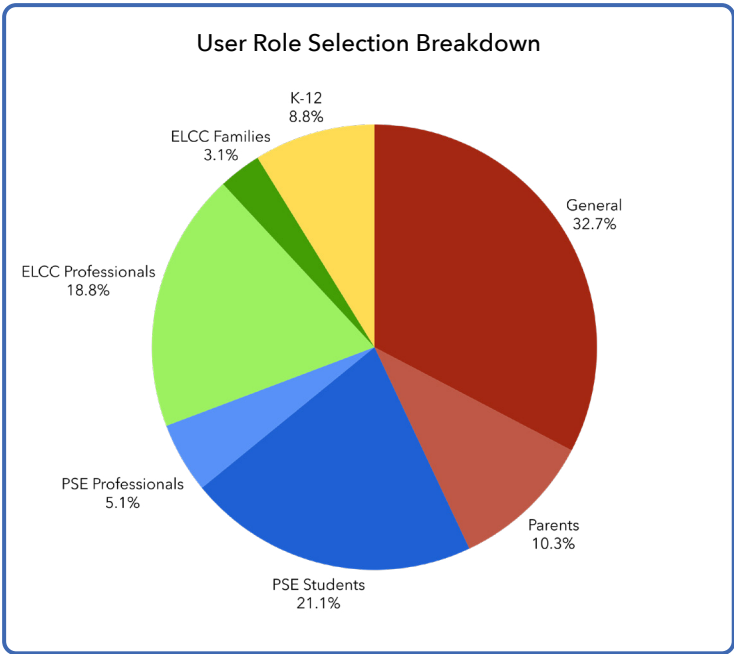
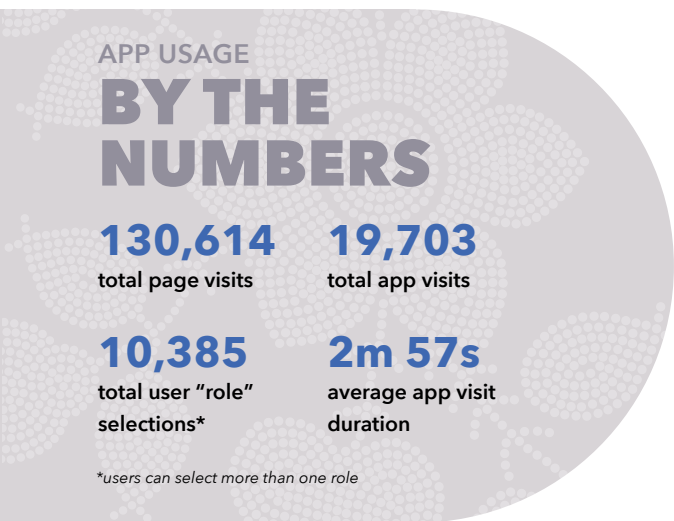
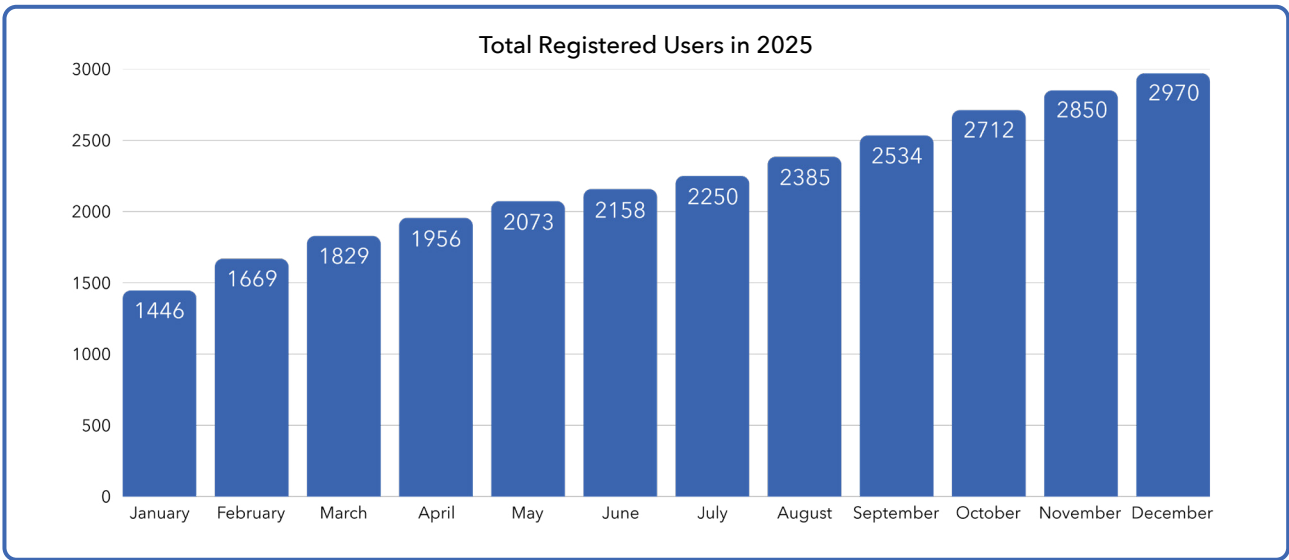

It features content from all teams in the Education & Training Branch, including live events, moderated discussions, application cycle notifications, and centralized access to resources (e.g. support programs, housing support, financial literacy guides, student handbooks, and more).

The MNO Education Hub is continually updated with new virtual and in-person events for users to register for, including info sessions and educational and cultural workshops. NOTIFICATIONS

The MNO Education Hub features regularly posted announcements – often sharing news regarding upcoming registration application periods and program news – which trigger notifications on users' phones. Additional news and important updates can also be sent as SMS and email notifications to users according to which roles they have selected, ensuring users are sent notifications that are relevant to their interests. Further notification preferences can also be edited in the settings menu.

ABOUT EDUCATION & TRAINING

The MNO began to offer training initiatives in 1996 with funding from the Métis Human Resources Development Agreement. Since then, the Education and Training Branch has grown and developed to include a comprehensive infrastructure that delivers a full range of programs. It supports the educational success of all Métis across Ontario, beginning in early learning, continuing through kindergarten to grade twelve, into adulthood through post-secondary education, and then into employment. We also work to retain and revitalize our languages, honour our culture and way of life, and provide ongoing learning outside formal education structures.

As a branch, we advocate for an inclusive education system by ensuring a Métis voice in education decisions, including developing education policies and programs within Ontario. Our expertise and investments are critical to educational outreach, resource development, education action plan development, and implementation through productive engagement with Provincial and Federal ministries. We continue to foster partnerships between communities and school boards, colleges, universities, the employment sector, and other key stakeholders to create a culture of lifelong learning within our communities. We are here to support those Métis learners, educators, job seekers, and citizens who engage within education systems.

We take pride in our culture and history, recognize and honour the Métis knowledge holders and senators who contribute to our way of life, teaching and learning opportunities, and take pride in our Métis languages. We look forward to sharing our traditions with future generations as we aspire to achieve our highest potential.
