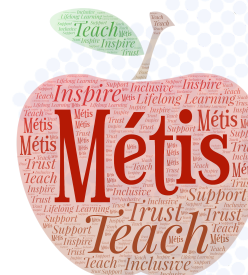


National Indigenous Peoples Day - June 21
