Credit River Métis Council

March 24, 2026

Through a PCMNO motion, I was appointed Electoral Officer to supervise the Credit River Métis Council's election scheduled for April 13-16, 2026. I was responsible for conducting, overseeing, and being accountable for all matters related to the community council's election, ensuring an impartial process, and taking any necessary steps to ensure a fair election consistent with the implementation of the Credit River Métis Council Electoral Code.

There are nine (9) positions on the council. Following the close of nominations on March 19, 2026, ten (10) nominations were submitted to fill nine (9) positions. One (1) nomination was withdrawn. Of the remaining nine (9) nominations, all were verified as candidates. As there were no contested positions and the council met quorum, there will be no voting in the election.

As per Article B33.1 of the Credit River Métis Community Council Electoral Code, it is my duty to announce the election results and declare the following candidates have been elected by acclamation to a four (4) year term:
