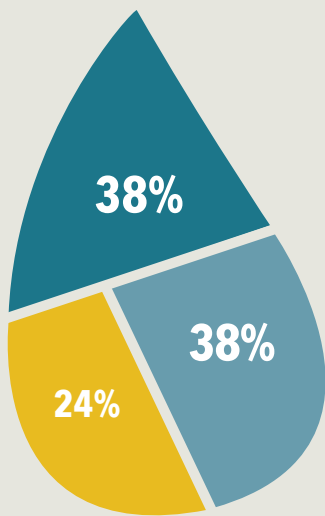

2025 FISH MONITORING SURVEY RESULTS

In early 2025, the MNO Environment and Climate Change team conducted a survey for MNO citizens who fish. See the key findings of survey below:

CITIZENS FISHED WITHIN MNO TRADITIONAL TERRITORIES



73%

38% of citizens fished recreational

24% fished for food

38% fished for both purposes

CITIZENS ARE CATCHING BASS, WALLEYE, AND NORTHERN PIKE



MOST FISHING TRIPS DID NOT ENCOUNTER INVASIVE SPECIES



92%

of fishing trips did not encounter invasive species

General health of fish was reported as good or excellent, none were reported as poor.

AVERAGE TIME SPENT FISHING



5 hours

Time spent fishing was fairly evenly split between morning, afternoon and evening.
