

# MÉTIS NATION OF ONTARIO ELECTION ANNOUNCEMENT

April 23, 2026

**COUNCIL:** Historical Sault Ste Marie Métis Council

**ELECTION DATES:** June 1 to June 4, 2026

An election has been scheduled for all positions on the Historical Sault Ste Marie Métis Council (HSSMMC) to serve a two (2) year term, in accordance with the Métis Nation of Ontario (MNO) Community Charter Agreement, Bylaws, and Community Council Electoral Code.

- All registered Métis citizens 16 and over who live within the council boundaries are encouraged to participate in this election as a candidate or by exercising their right to vote.
- All eligible voters can vote for the Senator position.
- Only Métis youth aged 16–29 can vote for the Youth Rep.
- All Métis Women who have identified as a woman with Registry can vote for the Women's Rep.

If you are interested in putting your name forward for a volunteer council position, a nomination form is included with this notice.

## ELEVEN (11) POSITIONS ON THE COUNCIL INCLUDE:

- PRESIDENT
- CHAIR
- SECRETARY
- TREASURER
- SENATOR
- WOMEN'S REPRESENTATIVE
- YOUTH REPRESENTATIVE
- COUNCILOR-AT-LARGE (four [4] positions)

*There is no in-person voting at a polling station. Voting will be conducted online or by phone. Instructions on registering and voting are provided in this package and online.*

From **June 1, 2026**, at **12:00 PM** through to **June 4, 2026**, closing at **8:00 PM** local time.

As the polls open, you will receive your unique voter PIN by email. Digital voting is available throughout the dates and times listed above. To vote online, go to the [OneFeather website](https://onefeather.ca/nations/mno) and follow the instructions. To obtain your voter PIN, you must first **activate your voter account**. You may also activate your account and vote by phone; see telephone voting for details.

If you plan to vote by phone or are having trouble voting online, support is available to vote verbally with a Returning Officer on the dates and times listed above. Call the toll-free number at 1-855-923-3006 and follow the prompts. If you reach an answering machine, leave a clear message with your name, area code, phone number, and indicate which election you are voting for. A Returning Officer will return your call.

## HOW TO RUN FOR A POSITION ON THE COMMUNITY COUNCIL:

- Citizens must have a complete MNO Registry file.
- Community Council citizens can be nominated for **one (1) Council position only**.
- At least **three (3) signatures of eligible voters** who support the nomination, as per the [Electoral Code Part B, article B7.2](#), are required on the nomination form.
- Complete both sides/pages of the nomination form and submit it to the Electoral Officer **before** the close of the nomination deadline date and time.
- Your primary residence and address must be within the Council's Charter boundaries (see right column).
- For verification, the MNO Registry requires an **updated proof of address** identification document (i.e. valid Ontario driver's license) that can be submitted with your nomination form. For more information on other acceptable ID, please contact the MNO Registry at 1-855-798-1006.

## OPENING OF NOMINATIONS:

**April 28, 2026 at 9:00 AM (ET)**

Both sides of the nomination form must be legible, fully completed, and signed. Nomination forms can be scanned or photographed and emailed or mailed to the Electoral Officer.

## CLOSE OF NOMINATIONS DEADLINE:

**May 12, 2026 at 6:00 PM (ET)**

The Electoral Officer **must receive** all nomination forms by the specified date and time. Incomplete or late nomination forms will not be accepted. If you are concerned about mail delivery, please submit your nomination form via [email](#) to ensure it arrives on time.

## ANNOUNCEMENT OF OFFICIAL CANDIDATES:

**May 15, 2026 at 6:00 PM (ET)**

After the close of nominations, the Electoral Officer will ask the MNO Registrar to verify the nominee's file, proof of address, and eligibility to hold office. The verification process takes up to three (3) business days. Those candidates who do not meet the verification requirements will not be eligible to participate. Additional time for Registry verifications may result in slight delays in posting the official list of candidates. If all candidates are acclaimed and the council has met quorum, there will be no online voting, and the official results will be posted.
