- Preparing and launching data collection planning for the 2027 MNO Housing Census
- Renewing and expanding Housing Stabilization funding
- Increasing the affordable housing inventory across regions
- Expanding research partnerships and knowledge sharing
- Continuing implementation of the 2024-2034 Housing & Homelessness Action Plan
