This notice may be reposted pending the outcome of this call to fill the vacancy.

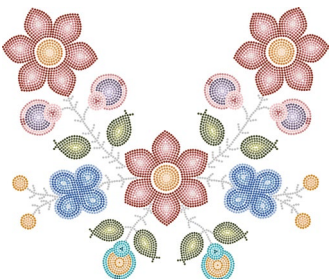
